

# Examples of student projects undertaken as part of Making Integration Work

## Long Term conditions:

- *Developing a Whole System approach at CHP level: gaining agreement by key staff of a model for managing people with complex needs.*
- *Integrated Project on Intensive Long Term Condition Management: A contemporary Reflective Review to inform organisational learning.*
- *Developing a local CHP Action Plan for the management of people with long term conditions.*
- *Improving pathways of care for people leaving prison: integrating Prison Health Care, NHS, private sector and voluntary sector organisations.*
