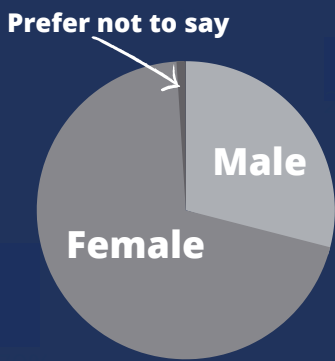
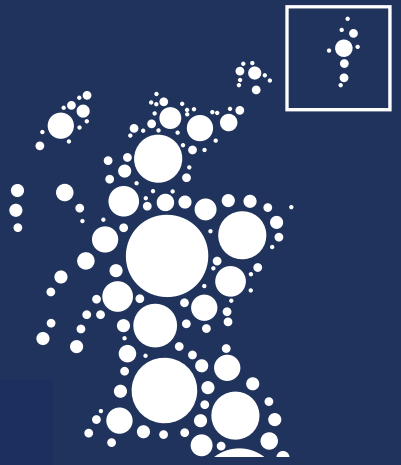

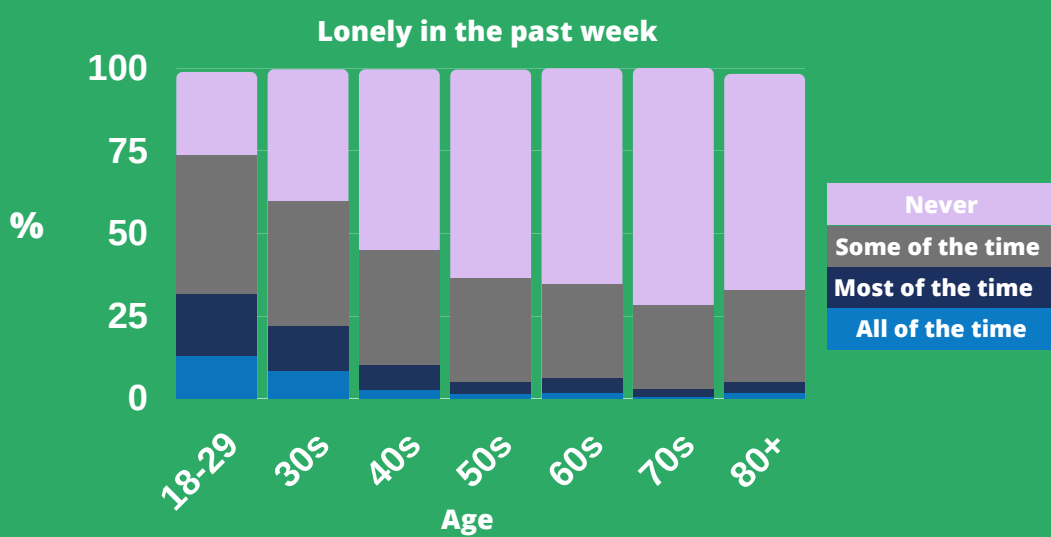
## LONELINESS

38% reported feeling lonely some or all of the time

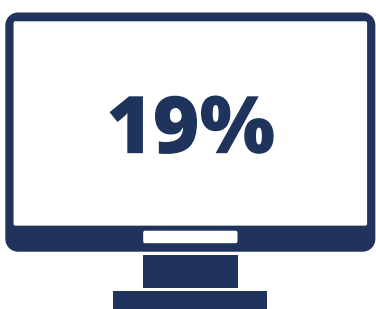
Higher levels of loneliness were reported in

Reported their broadband connection was poor or very poor

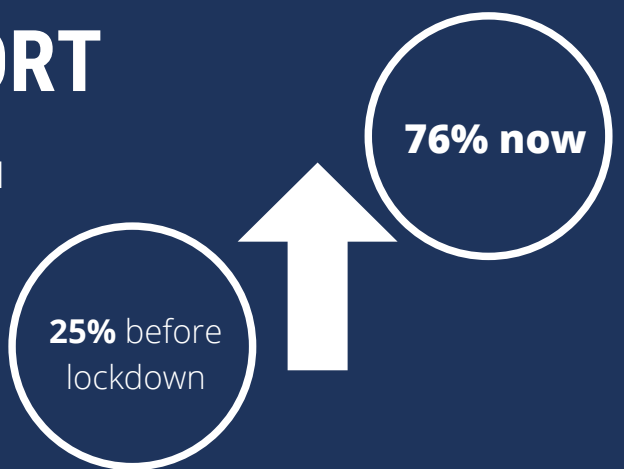


Said high-speed broadband was very important to be able to work from home
