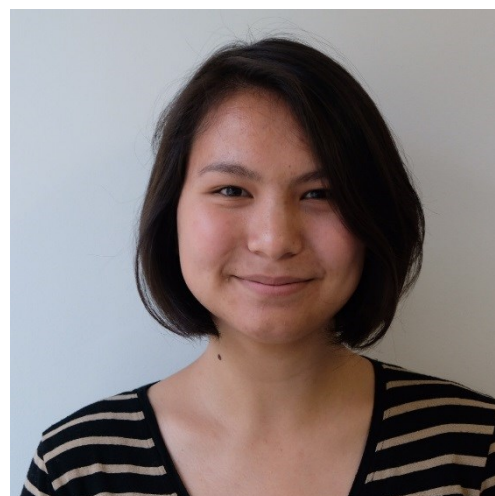




Employ.ed on Campus 2018 Internship Case Study
