Studying the PgCert in Carbon Innovation

The programme is comprised of three courses that move from the economics of climate change and its impacts, through the key assessment and accounting measurement methodologies of its impacts, adaptation and mitigation, to examination of the engineering and social response to the energy challenge, and the risks and opportunities it represents. The courses draw on expert input from some of the world's leading authorities on the subject, including government advisors and industry specialists.

Compulsory courses typically will be*:

- Carbon Economics
- Climate Change Measurement
- Energy and Climate

**Courses are offered subject to availability and are subject to change.*

Programme Delivery and Duration

This is a part time Online Distance Learning PgCert, typically studied for 12 months online from September. This Certificate may be studied alone as a standalone qualification, but also forms one third of the online *MSc Carbon Management*.

Entry Requirements

A UK 2:1 degree, or its international equivalent, in any subject. Professional experience will also be taken into account

English Language Requirements

IELTS 7.0 (with no score lower than 6.0 in each section)

TOEFL-iBT: Total 100 (with no score lower than 20 in each section). A degree from an English speaking university may be accepted in some circumstances.

Indicative tuition fees*:

Home/EU/ International - £4,900

Please note that fees typically rise around 5% each year.
