The University of Edinburgh welcomes you to the Easter Bush Campus.

This leaflet provides details of the ambitious development programme planned for Easter Bush, as well as information to keep you safe when you are on the Campus.



### FAQs

#### Will there be more traffic in/around the Campus?

Yes - there will inevitably be more traffic on Campus, including HGVs and other construction vehicles. We have asked that all contractors use the southern entrance to the Campus, approaching from either the Gowkley Moss roundabout (A701) or the A702. A maximum 20 mph speed limit will apply to all areas within the Campus. As always, please be alert when moving around the Campus.

#### What should I do if I have any more questions?

You should contact one of the reception desks on Campus in the first instance. They will help where possible, or refer you to the person who can best assist.

### FAQs continued

#### Will there be any major changes to normal day-to-day Campus activities?

No - we do not anticipate any major changes to Campus business, including teaching, research and clinical facilities. Opening hours for buildings remain as normal.

#### Are there any changes to Campus access?

Yes - the exit road from the equine car park will be closed during the construction period. The current entrance road will be altered from a one-way into a two-way system. The car park itself will be rearranged to create end on spaces against the site hoarding.

There are no other significant planned changes to Campus access, but any updates will be posted on the web page (please see the 'Further Information' section of this leaflet for details).

#### Will contractors have access to the existing buildings?

No - the majority of contractors will not be accessing the existing buildings and will supply catering for their own staff, so we do not expect a huge increase in footfall in the cafes or increased use of other Campus facilities.

#### Will there be any changes to parking on Campus?

No - contractor parking has been allocated to a section of the red car park only, so there should be no major changes to parking on Campus, even if you use the red car park.

The University of Edinburgh is now embarking on the next stage of its exciting development at the Campus. A number of new, world class facilities are planned for construction in the next two years, including an Energy Centre, Centre Building, Large Animal Facilities and much improved Campus infrastructure. Facilities will also provide a retail unit; gym; research, teaching, exhibition and outreach space; support services and separate nursery building. With this in mind, this document aims to provide some general information on the projects and construction programme.
