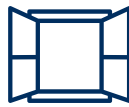
Beyond level 0 we remain committed to delivering clean and safe environments when providing Delivered Hospitality.

In line with mandatory and advisory Scottish Government requirements, we require a number of protective measures to be in place to help reduce the spread of COVID-19.



FACE COVERINGS

Face coverings should be worn at all times when indoors, unless a person is exempt. This includes while seated, moving around and queuing at the catering station. Face coverings can be removed while eating and drinking.



VENTILATION

Increase the volume of outside air at your chosen location by opening windows, doors and vents, and take regular fresh air breaks throughout the event. If your location does not have operational windows or doors, ensure sufficient mechanical ventilation is available and working.



RESPECTFUL DISTANCING

To ensure all guests feel comfortable at your event, we encourage guests to maintain a respectful distance from each other and the Delivered Hospitality team. It is also important the number of guests is appropriate and proportionate to the size of the room.



CHECK IN SCOTLAND

As required, NHS Test & Protect data will be captured via the Check In Scotland app as guests enter the Delivered Hospitality catering room. We recommend you capture these details at the start of your event.



HYGIENE MEASURES

We provide hand sanitisers at your catering station and all of our delivery vehicles are equipped with a travel hygiene kit and are sanitised regularly.



FOOD & BEVERAGE

We adhere to strict health and safety measures when preparing and serving food. Menus and service options have been modified in order to reduce contact points.
