

Rules for accessing the William Robertson Wing out of hours

Access to the building is only available to students in these categories:

- Year 4 HCA student
- Joint honours enrolled on HCA dissertation
- EUSA UG representative
- Society office-holder (ArchSoc, Classics Society, EAOP, History Society, Retrospect)
- Student Ambassador
- Peer Support volunteer
- SRR volunteer
- History for Schools volunteer
- Literacy through Latin volunteer
- Robertson International Scholarship winner
- Prize Winners 2018/2019

Please remember that you signed a form which agreed:

- sign in and out of the building each time you use it – signing-in book by front door from Teviot Place
- read and abide by the “Policy on Lone Working and Out of Hours Working” (taking note of the procedures in the event of an emergency)
- show consideration for other users of the building, including keeping noise at reasonable levels
- student rooms will be accessible as normal, teaching rooms must be booked through the normal room booking system
- keep rooms tidy and return furniture to its original position at the end
- not to eat or drink in teaching rooms (anything other than water)

The extended access is being granted on the basis that these are kept and will be revoked if they are not.
