

BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR APPLICATION PLEASE BE PREPARED TO UPLOAD THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTATION

1. Upload your **Degree Certificate** or Formal Letter from your university if you have yet to graduate (any offer of a place would then be conditional on providing final documentation following graduation)
2. Upload a final **Degree Transcript** (or Interim Transcript if not yet graduated)
3. Upload **Two References** (references must be on headed paper, dated and signed by the referee)
4. If English is not your first language, you will need to provide evidence of proficiency in English eg. IELTS or TOEFL

All of the above documents should be uploaded when you are ready to start your application to the University of Edinburgh, College of Medicine and Veterinary Medicine. Failure to provide these supporting documents could delay the application process.

Please ensure that you are uploading a document of 2MB or less, and of one the following types: .doc, .docx, .rtf, .pdf, .txt, .jpg, .gif, .zip, .xls. Documents larger than 2MB initially may appear to upload, but will not display properly when you are invited to view the uploaded file. If this happens, you should opt to upload a different document.

NOTE:

Following the submission of your application, you still have the opportunity to upload more documents. If you experience problems uploading your documents please try to keep documents small to improve processing time and close all other internet programmes.

It would be helpful if you would name all documentation appropriately e.g. Transcript, Reference 1. If documents fail to upload (e.g. page not found message returned) it is likely to be the result of your local internet connection capabilities.

In addition, you can upload up to two additional documents that are relevant to your application and not specified above e.g. if you hold more than one degree you may upload an additional degree certificate.
