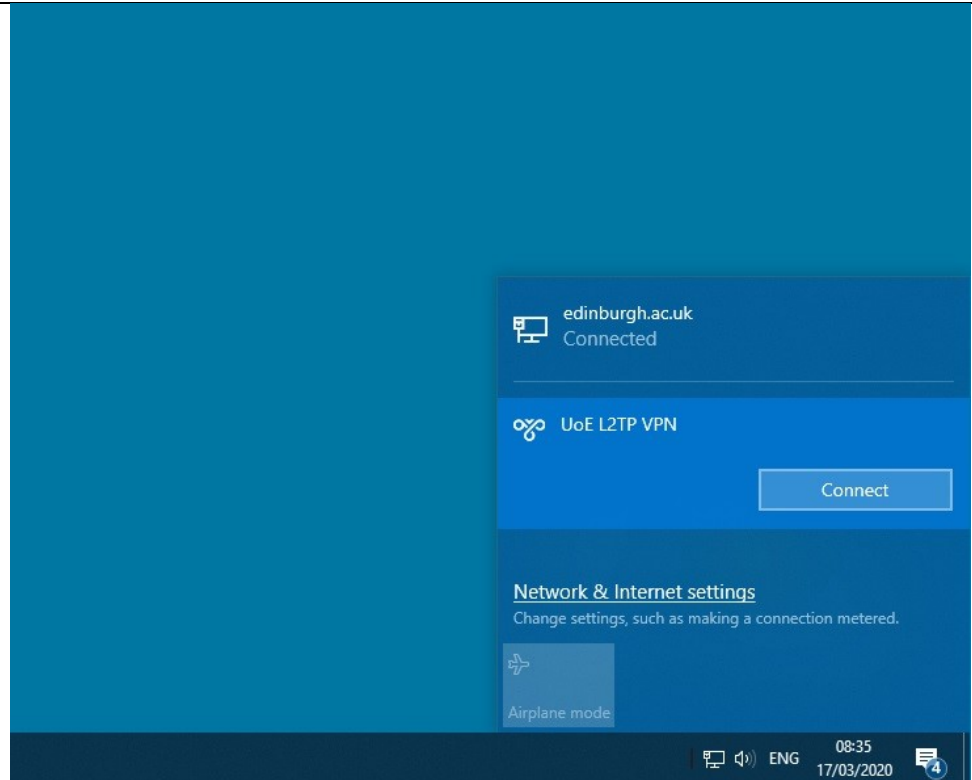

Enter the following details:

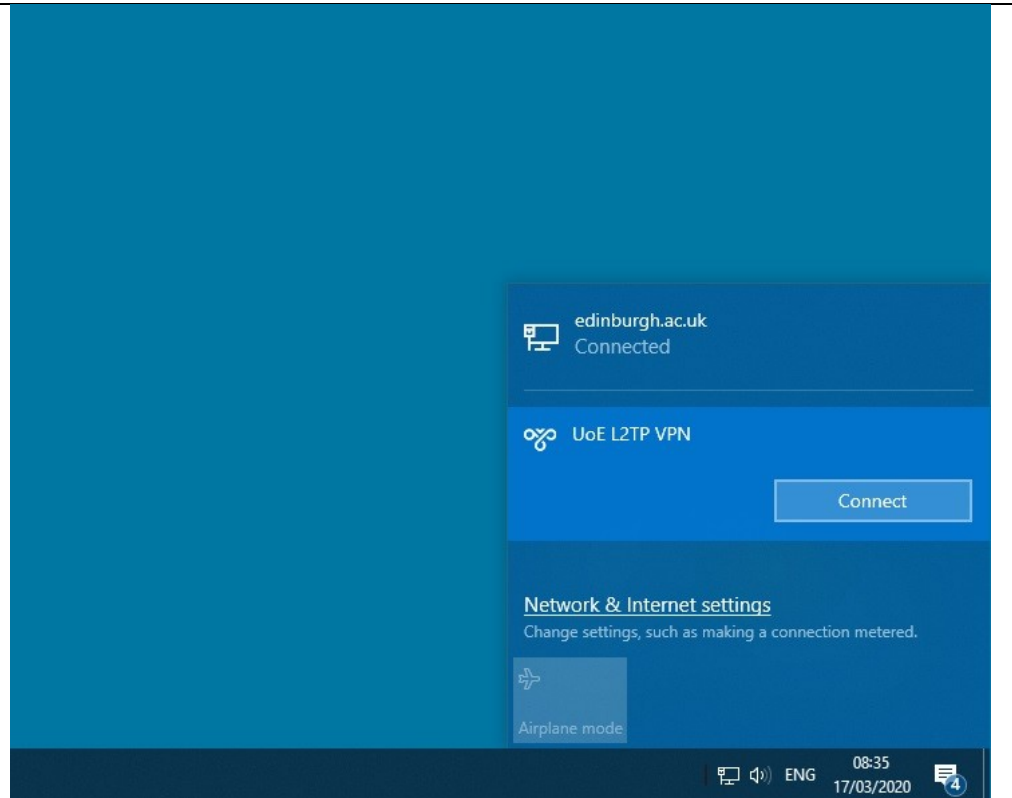
- VPN provider: Windows (built-in)
- Connection name: UoE L2TP VPN
- Server name or address: remote.net.ed.ac.uk
- VPN type: L2TP/IPsec with pre-shared key
- Pre-shared key: Zt6337ZnVLhN
- Type of sign-in info: User name and password
- Leave everything else blank and select "Save"



Left click on the network icon in the bottom right hand side of the screen
 Select "UoE L2TP VPN" and click Connect



Enter your UUN and VPN password (set when you registered)
Click "OK"



The status should now change to "Connected"
