Clients are welcome to consider a “consultation only” visit to our specialist services. We will advise to the best of our abilities how to proceed with the patient and we will provide your own veterinary surgeon with a written report summarising our findings and recommendations. Please let our clinicians know if this is your preferred option.

Individual Services

Cardiopulmonary

The basic cost for investigation of a routine cardiac or respiratory case is approximately: £515 - £1,700.

This includes an appropriate selection of the following: consultation, routine haematology and biochemistry profile, cardiac biomarkers, electrocardiography, Holter analysis, thoracic radiography, echocardiography, bronchoscopy, bronchoalveolar lavage, CT, airway sample cytology and culture and sensitivity.

Dermatology

The basic cost for the initial work up of a dermatological case ranges from: £110 - £825. CT imaging and video-otoscopy treatment of chronic otitis ranges from £1,030 - £1,545.

Hair plucks, skin scrapes or cytology: £25 each

Intradermal allergen test with up to 50 allergens - £220

Allergen specific immunotherapy (including sub-lingual) induction: £130 - £185

Allergen specific immunotherapy (including sub-lingual) maintenance: £90 - £120

Video otoscopy and ear flush: £270 - £410 (plus anaesthetic)

Laser treatments £195 - £415 (plus anaesthetic)

Skin or nail biopsy: £110 - £150 (plus sedation/ anaesthetic and histopathology)

Many skin conditions are on-going and require lifelong treatment. This adds to the overall cost, but we will discuss the costs of different treatment options with clients to help them make the best decision for their animal.

Exotics

Treatment prices range from approximately: £300 - £3,090

Rabbit dental treatment: £200 - £310

Diagnostic work up for sick exotic pet: £420 - £1,030

Longer term in patients (medical) with diagnostics and treatment: £820 - £2,060

Complex surgical cases including diagnostics and critical care: £1,030 - £2,575

Internal Medicine

Treatment prices range from approximately: £640 - £3,200.

Investigation of chronic diarrhoea: £640 - £1,700

Investigation of chronic anaemia: £640 - £2,130

Investigation of pyrexia of unknown origin: £1,050 - £2,700

Treatment of hyperthyroidism by radioactive iodine: £1,600 - £2,400

Treatments can range up to £6,200 depending on the complexity of the case.

Interventional Radiology

Treatment prices range from approximately: £1,445 - £6,700

Urethral stent: £1,650 - £3,100

Laser lithotripsy for urinary stones, ureteral stent: £2,060 - £4,020

Urethral collagen injection for incontinence, laser ablation of ectopic ureters or transjugular coil embolization IHPSS: £3,710 - £6,700

Chemoembolization: £2,060 - £4,120

Tracheal stent: £1,550 - £2,060

Nasopharyngeal balloon/stent: £1,350 - £9,070

Oesophageal/colonic stents: £1,860 - £2,580

Treatment prices for cardiac interventional procedures range from £3,000 to £3,960

Pacemaker implantation: £3,960

Balloon valvuloplasty: £3,000

PDA amplatzer: £3,000

Oncology

Treatment prices range from approximately: £637 - £4,244.

Cancer staging: £400 - £1,400

Multidrug therapy for Lymphoma: £2,500 - £4,000

Chemotherapy: £1,200- £4,000

Definitive radiation therapy: £3,200 - £5,000

Palliative radiation therapy: £1,000 - £1,200

Targeted therapy: £500 - £700

Treatments can cost more depending on the complexity of the case.

Orthopaedics and Neurosurgery

Treatment prices range from approximately: £585 - £4,740.

Cranial cruciate ligament disease: £1,290 - £3,200

Medial patella luxation: £1,400 - £3,200

Fracture repair: £1,290 - £3,500

Total hip replacement: £3,710 - £4,800

Developmental elbow disease: £930 - £2,990

Arthroscopic treatment of joint disease: £1,135 - £2,370

Spinal decompression: £2,060 - £4,225

Advanced Imaging: CT from £640 / MRI from £745

Soft Tissue Surgery

Perineal herniorrhaphy: £1,750 - £2,680

Laryngeal tie-back: £1,960- £2,370

Brachycephalic airway surgery (without tracheostomy): £1,545 - £1,960

Abdominal surgery simple, canine (e.g. enterectomy): £1,960 - £2,680

Abdominal surgery complex, canine (e.g. septic peritonitis) £2,680 - £5,360

Gastric dilatation and volvulus (simple): £2,060 - £3,815

Portosystemic shunt: £2,060 - £5,360

Total ear canal ablation: £1,960 - £2,680

If your pet is not insured: a 50% deposit of the upper estimated treatment cost is required. In all cases, payment is required upon discharge of your pet.
