Paying for your postgraduate study


- Less funding available than for UG

 - Working while studying?










- For each Online Learning programme there is only one 'fee status'







General Funding Tips

- 1. Submit your application for a place on the programme first
- 2. Request references well in advance
- Look early and keep checking regularly
- 4. Pay careful attention to closing dates
- 5. Spend time putting together your funding application
- 6. Apply for as many awards as possible
- 7. Apply separately for funding for each programme


