



Disability and Learning Support Service









What do we do?

- Discuss support previously received/required now
- Screen for certain learning differences/ neurodiverse conditions
- Produce and distribute schedule of reasonable adjustments/accommodations
- Advise on technology and equipment
- Loan equipment/assistive technology
- Assistance in applying for Disabled Students' Allowance (DSA) if eligible
- If ineligible, University will provide funding, so support will remain same.





- Based in the Nucleus, Kings Buildings and Main Library Building, George Square








Our offer




