#### **General Funding Tips**

- 1. Submit your application for a place on the programme first
- 2. Request references well in advance
- 3. Look early and keep checking regularly
- 4. Pay careful attention to scholarship closing dates
- 5. Spend time putting together your funding application
- 6. Apply for as many awards as possible
- 7. Apply separately for funding for each programme
