

- At the heart of one of the world's most beautiful cities





Our masters programmes

- Highly intensive typically 1-year
- Internationally recognised qualification – Bologna compliant

Taught Masters

- Two 10-week semesters culminating in a dissertation over the summer
- Mix of core and optional courses, often including opportunity for interdisciplinary study

Masters by Research

 Introductory research training culminating in a substantial research project




