Edinburgh Award (Business School and Professional Development – Undergraduate)

This Award is given to Undergraduate Students in the Business School whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel in their professional development. These students have experienced group coaching and engaged with development sessions to increase the professional development of themselves and their peers.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase awareness of their strengths
- make the most of their strengths, identify areas for development, and work on a plan to develop these skills
- confidently demonstrate what they have to offer to others
- achieve a positive and lasting impact
- look not only at their professional development, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their professional development, and vice versa.
