We intend to present the final results of CARE at the 2024 SBNS meeting which will be held at the EICC in Edinburgh between 16-19 April 2024.

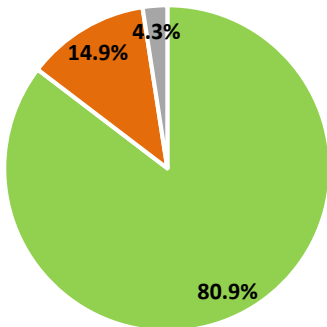
### Recruitment

### Main priorities over the next 5 months

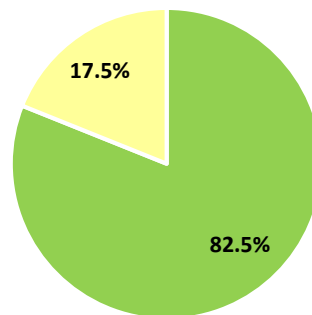
- (1) **Report any clinical outcomes** (details on page 2)

## Clinical Outcome Event Reporting

**If any of the following clinical outcome events occur following randomisation they must be recorded in the CARE eCRF:**

- **Intracranial haemorrhage or new persistent/progressive focal neurological deficit due to brain cavernoma or surgical management, whether fatal or non-fatal.**
- **Death not due to a primary clinical outcome.**
