Edinburgh Award (Charity Fundraising)

This award is given to students whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a charity fundraiser. These students have taken responsibility for the creation, planning and organisation of their own fundraising activities with the aim of raising funds for specific charities and raising the profile of those charities.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase their self-awareness;
- make the most of their existing strengths and build new skills/abilities against clear development goals;
- understand the processes involved in having a planned positive impact and strategically working to excel, enabling them to have impact and make a difference whatever situation they are in; and
- look not only at their fundraising, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as a charity fundraiser, and vice versa.
