Edinburgh Award (School of Chemistry: Outreach and Public Engagement - Leadership)

This award is given to students within the School of Chemistry whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact as a leader within outreach activities. These students have volunteered their time throughout the year to communicate chemistry to a public (non-university or non-chemistry) audience through involvement in a variety of activities.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase their self-awareness;
- make the most of their existing strengths and build new skills/abilities against clear development goals;
- understand the processes involved in having a planned positive impact and strategically working to excel, enabling them to have impact and make a difference whatever situation they are in; and
- look not only at their outreach role, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as an outreach volunteer and leader, and *vice versa*.
