

Edinburgh Award (Employ.ed On Campus Internship)

This award is given to students whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a University intern. These students have successfully completed a structured summer internship programme in a University of Edinburgh department, including a specialised programme of support designed to enhance their employability.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase their self-awareness;
- make the most of their existing strengths and build new skills/abilities against clear development goals;
- understand the processes involved in having a planned positive impact and strategically working to excel, enabling them to have impact and make a difference whatever situation they are in; and
- look not only at their internship, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as an intern and vice versa.
