


Outline comparison of findings

- main issue existential or spiritual distress
- analgesia effective
- anger in the face of illness
- "just keep it to myself"
- spiritual needs evident but unmet

- main issue physical suffering, especially pain
- analgesia unaffordable
- acceptance rather than anger
- community support accepted
- patients comforted and inspired by belief in God
