Edinburgh Award (Maths Outreach)

This award is given to students in the School of Mathematics whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as an outreach volunteer. These students have not only volunteered their time throughout the year to communicate mathematics to a public (non-university or non-maths) audience through involvement in a variety of activities but have taken charge of the design and organisation of at least one outreach activity.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to: 2

- increase awareness of their strengths
- make the most of their strengths, identify areas for development, and work on a plan to develop these skills
- confidently demonstrate what they have to offer to others
- achieve a positive and lasting impact
- look not only at their outreach activities, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as an outreach volunteer, and vice versa.
