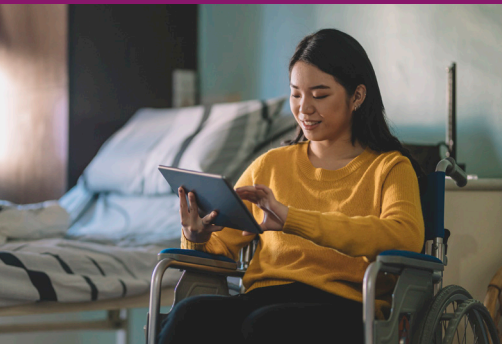

**The Programme**

The aim of this programme is to equip registered nurses working in neurological rehabilitation, through education and reflection on their own practice, with the skills and resources to develop person-centred, partnership-focused practice in the area of neurological care and rehabilitation of adults.

Central to the programme is a truly holistic care-based approach, where we focus on the emotional, physical, cognitive, mental well-being and social needs of the individual, as well as those of their families and carers.

We work with international clinical partners in the field with an interdisciplinary approach that focuses on the mind and the body.

A particular emphasis will be placed on the rehabilitation of people aged 18-40 - a relatively neglected area.
