Edinburgh Award (Pro Science)

This award is given to students whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a classroom volunteer through Pro Science. These students have volunteered their time in secondary schools' science classes to enhance pupils' understanding of, enthusiasm for, and achievement in, their specialist science subject.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase their self-awareness;
- make the most of their existing strengths and build new skills/abilities against clear development goals;
- understand the processes involved in having a planned positive impact and strategically working to excel, enabling them to have impact and make a difference whatever situation they are in; and
- look not only at their Pro Science volunteering, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as a Pro Science volunteer, and vice versa.
