Recruitment

- The current number of participants recruited in March was 17 and our overall total now stands at 113 (as of 9th April)
 well done all!
- Top recruiting site for March is Newcastle with 4 participants. Well done to them.
- Hot on Newcastle's heels, we have Edinburgh, Oxford and Devon & Exeter with 3 each, NHS Borders with 2 and Lanarkshire and Durham & Darlington with 1 each.
- If your site is a large site, we are asking for 4 randomisations a month and for smaller sites, 2 a month. Sites hitting the milestone figures (120th, 130th, etc.) will receive tokens of our appreciation. Thank you in advance for your efforts!



Sites

- 2 new sites opened in March James Cook University Hospital and Horton Hospital. We now have 15 sites open to recruitment A very warm welcome to all!
- Several new sites have had their SIVs University Hospital of North Tees, Southampton General Hospital, Hereford County Hospital. We look forward to getting you up and running.
- SIVs are in the diary for Victoria Hospital, Kirkcaldy; Ipswich; Wrightington, Wigan and Leigh; and Worcester.

FAQs

Q: A participant has been discharged from acute hospital before the Day 3 (2-5) assessments were carried out — is this a deviation?

A: No, this isn't a deviation. The discharge date will be entered in REDCap, so it will be clear that these assessments were not able to be performed due to early discharge. A file note can be used to keep record of this in your ISF.

Q: Do I need to add patients that are pre-consented but not randomised to the main RESULT-Hip database?

A: No – all pre-consented patients should be recorded on the REDCap screening log, but only those who go on to be randomised need to be added to the main database.

Q: If a participant has already had a clinical transfusion are they still eligible for the study?

A: Yes, participants who have had a transfusion may still be randomised to the study granted that their most recent haemoglobin result falls below the trigger of <90g/L.

We are very pleased to tell you that following our end of pilot NIHR review meeting, the NIHR have agreed that the RESULT Hip trial should continue. They are however very keen that we have opened all 30 sites by the end of August and that we do everything we can to increase recruitment rate at sites to 2.5 participants per site per month open.

We have discussed in the recent site teleconference changing the sampling windows to a baseline sample and two further samples across the following 5 days which will allow more flexibility to recruit on a Friday, without losing ability to detect secondary outcomes. A substantial amendment to do this is in process.
