Edinburgh Award (School of Law: Student Leaders)

This award is given to students in the School of Law whom the University has recognised for actively working to maximise their impact and excel as a student leader. These students have taken on a wide variety of roles across the School from committees, societies, and councils to student groups, each adding to the student experience offered to the School's students.

In successfully completing the Edinburgh Award, these students will have been helped to:

- increase awareness of their strengths
- make the most of their strengths, identify areas for development, and work on a plan to develop these skills
- confidently demonstrate what they have to offer to others
- achieve a positive and lasting impact
- look not only at their student leadership, but also to capitalise on their experiences elsewhere to inform and enhance their role as a student leader, and vice versa
