

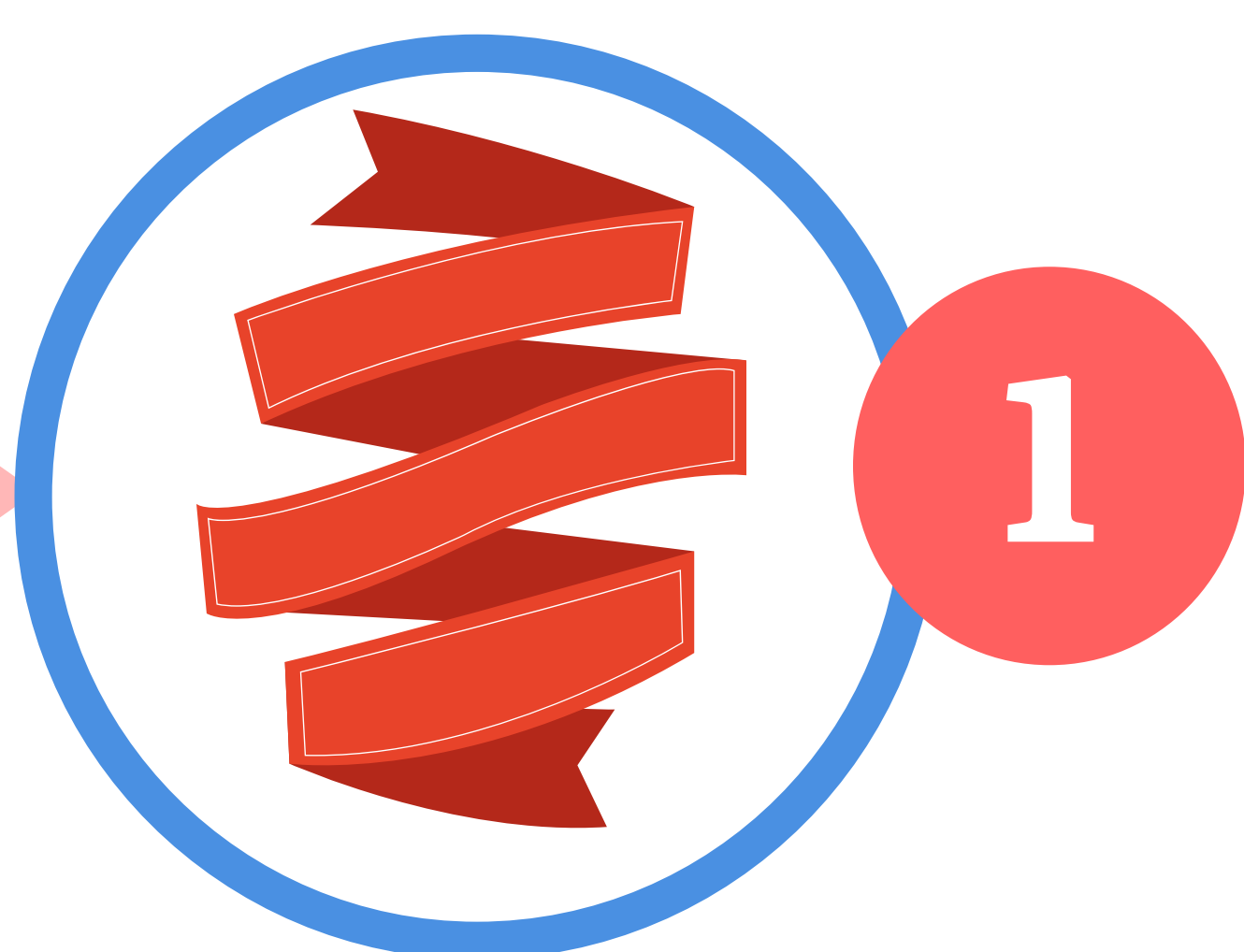

## Technician Commitment

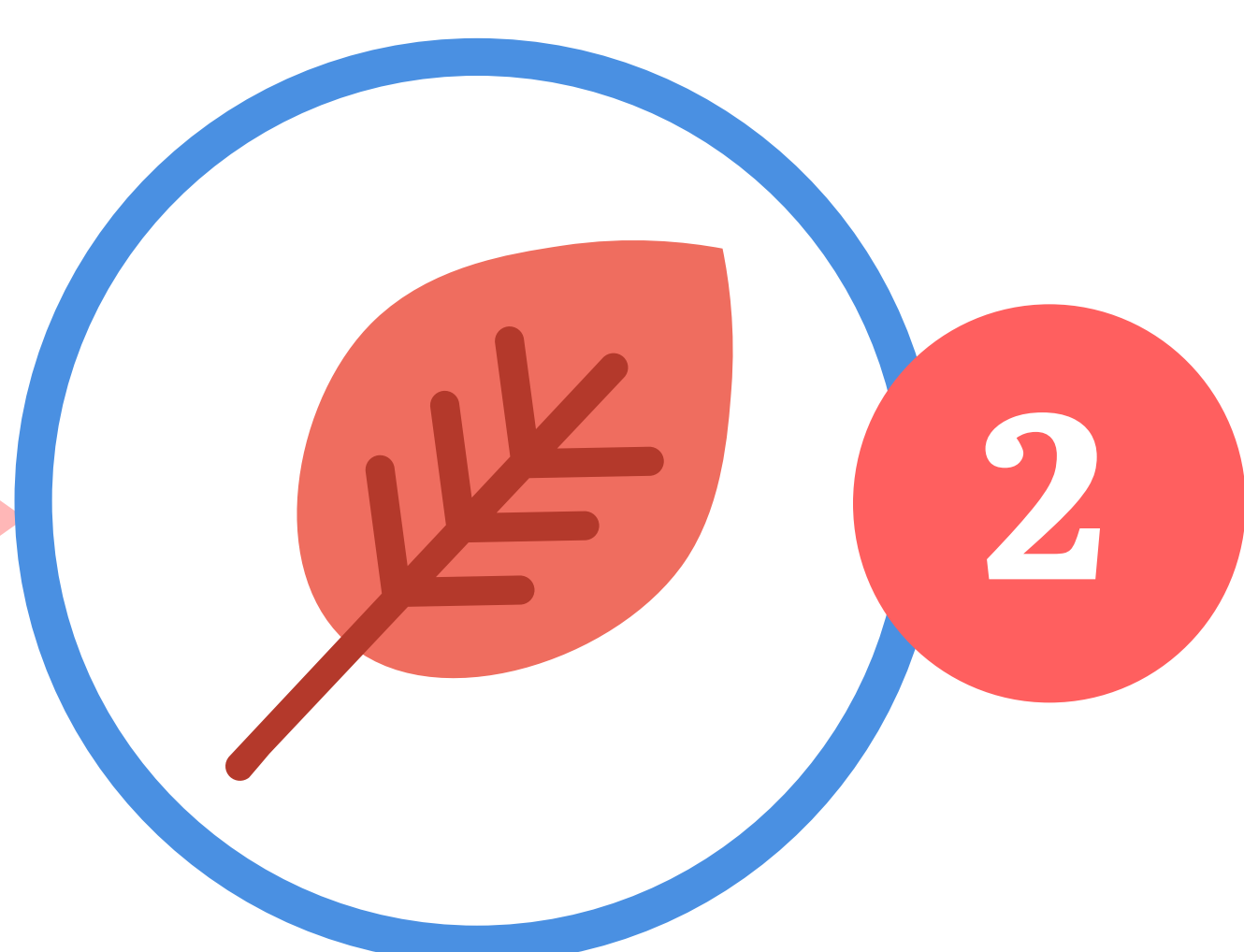

## TechNets

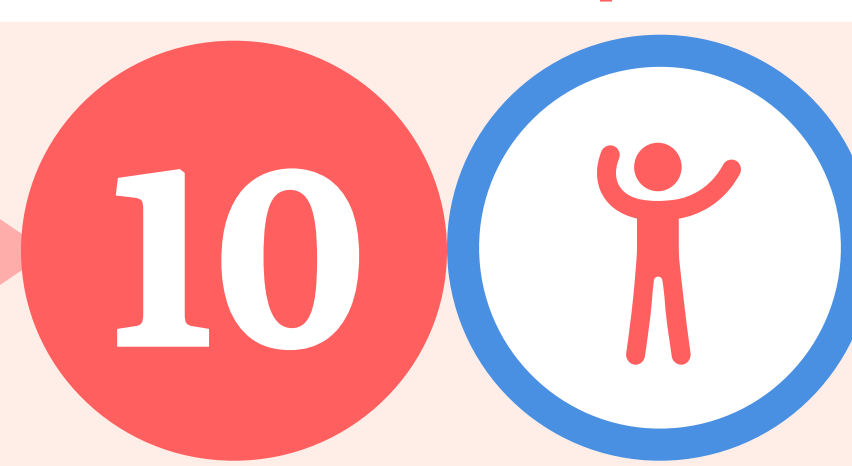
Meetings to discuss practice, talk about CPD, explore the benefits of professional qualifications and registry with professional bodies, and share resources.
