The aim: To develop a Care Home Innovation Partnership of care home managers and university researchers as part of the wider vision for ToRCH (Training and Research based Care Home). This evolved into a community of practice and trialled tests of change.

CHIP was originally led by Jo Hockley, with involvement from seven care homes. CHIP projects have included: Expanding student placements to involve other disciplines; Implementing Namaste Care; Improvements to electronic care planning; Understanding data collection practices in care homes; Palliative and end of life care training including online debriefs; Changes to controlled medication; Making a short film featuring a resident; Inclusion of care homes in conference planning. The CHIP is now supported by ENRICH Scotland and has involvement from five care homes.

CHIP continues to offer peer support & develop new research questions and quality improvement ideas. A toolkit to help establish new CHIPs has been developed. This has been used in forming a new CHIP in Greater Glasgow & Clyde Health and Social Care Partnerships care homes. CHIP now has
