The Secrets of Efficient and Effective Study (Steve Hutchinson) Mon 20 Feb 12.00-15.00



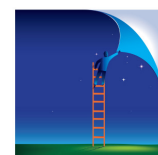
Rene Descartes once said that "it is not enough to have a great mind, the main thing is to use it well". So, how well do you use *your* great mind?

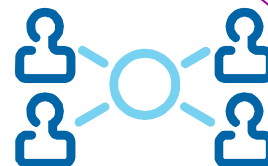
**Selling the Dream: professional
