

2015: FILM IN THE OLD COLLEGE QUAD EVENT INFORMATION:

Tickets

Screenings - £6.50 + booking fee per film.

Kids Matinees are FREE. Events will be split between Eventbrite & EdFringe for ticketing purposes.

T&Cs:

For your own safety and enjoyment we ask you to please follow the below:

Tickets:

- Tickets holders must bring proof of purchase in the form of a printed ticket. We will not be using the Eventbrite Neon App.
- Tickets cannot be returned or refunded unless the event is cancelled or rescheduled.
- Lost and damaged tickets will not be replaced. Keep your ticket and stub safe and in good condition.
- Tickets may not be sold, resold or used for promotional purpose without the written consent of the organisers.
- Entry to each film is based on the legal certification classified to each screening and persons **under the age of 16yrs** must be accompanied by an adult. **I.D must be provided when requested.** Failure to provide I.D may result in denied entry to the event and no refund.
- Please refer to each individual film for details of what time doors open to the public.

Venue and Accessibility:

- All screenings are open air in an unseated outdoor grass arena, the audience area is not covered. The screenings will go ahead whatever the weather.
- **There is no parking facilities available at the venue but there is a number of public transport options available. The venue is fully accessible with toilets on site, which will be managed by stewards.**
- **NO SMOKING is permitted on site, if you need to smoke, please go to the main entrance area.**

What can I bring?:

Seating: Please note, **NO CHAIRS** can be brought into the event arena, this is an unseated picnic style event. There will be no fixed seating in the Old College Quad and you are encouraged to bring rugs, blankets and cushions to get comfortable on the lawn. Viewing area is located picnic style on the lawn and a limited number of ground mats will be available at the event.

Should you require a seat for assistance or medical reasons please ask a member of staff who will be able to help, but please be courteous of other audience members and do not cause an obstructed view.

Food & Drink:

- **NO ALCOHOL** can be brought into the event arena. A licensed bar facility is available at the event.
- Picnics are permitted but Food and Drink will also be available to purchase on site.
- **NO GLASS** including bottles or ceramic crockery may be brought into the event arena.
- The consumption of alcohol from the licensed bar within the event arena is permitted. Alcohol will be sold in plastic containers.
- Please drink responsibly and respect the enjoyment and viewing of others.
- **NO RED WINE** will be available at the event in order to protect the paving stones in the Quad

- NO BARBECUES, NAKED FLAMES, GAS STOVES, CANDLES, TENTS OR GAZEBOS are permitted in the arena.

- Please use bins provided for rubbish and clean up any litter from your attendance.

PLEASE NOTE:

- On entering the event **you consent to** official filming, photography and sound recordings as members of the public, which may be used in future promotions by organisers.

- The use of **professional cameras** and any **audio / video recording equipment** by the public is **strictly prohibited** at the event.

- **No pets** allowed into the event arena – Guide Dogs and / or Hearing Dogs only.

- Organisers reserve the right to make **changes to advertised event time(s) and schedule(s)**.

- Organisers reserve the right to **implement any restrictions/conditions** deemed necessary before and during the event to ensure the safe management of the event.

Management reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone acting in a manner deemed inappropriate by management inside the event site. Anyone deemed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be refused entry or asked to leave the event.
